Sternhold and Hopkins (1562)

- 1 He that within the secret place
of God most high doth dwell,
Under the shadow of his grace
he shall be safe and well.
- 2 Thou art my hope and my
strong hold,
I to the Lord will say;
My God he is, in him will I
my whole affiance stay.
- 3 He shall defend thee from the
snare,
the which the hunter laid;
And from the deadly plague
and care
whereof thou art afraid:
- 4 And with his wings shall
cover thee,
and keep thee safely there:
His faith and truth thy fence
shall be
as sure as shield and spear.

The New Revised Standard Version (1989)

- 1 You who live in the
shelter of the Most High,
who abide in the
shadow of the Almighty,
- 2 will say to the LORD,
"My refuge and my fortress;
my God, in whom I
trust."
- 3 For he will deliver you
from the snare of the fowler
and from the deadly
pestilence;
- 4 he will cover you with his
pinions,
and under his wings
you will find refuge;
his faithfulness is a
shield and buckler.
