PHILO IVDÆVS .



His Philo was a Jew of *Alexandria*, of the stocke of the priests, and hee is deservedly placed among the Ecclesiasticall Writers, because that in his workes hee sets forth the prayes of the Christians.

He was sent Embassador by the Jews his Countymen to *Rome*, to plead for his whole Nation, and to qualifie *Caius* the Emperours anger, who was possessed against the Jews for divers crimes and enormities which they had committed; hoping by his endeavour and wisdom to set them right againe in the Emperours good opi-
