His great Father was born at *Athens*, but governed the Church of *Alexandria*, (as Saint *Hierom* witnesseth in his Catalogue) He was an auditor to *Pantenus* (who dying) this *Clemens* was Master of the *Catechists*, his Works are full of Learning and Eloquence, and wrote in a most elegant stile: take but what *Gentianus Hervet* produceth out of *Cyrrill* the Patriarch of *Alexandria* against *Julian*, for a true testimonie of this *Clemens* endowments and abilities. *Quam is autem utilis sit futurus, hinc potest evidenter perspicci. Suntne aliqui, qui priscis, & ex alto petitis delectantur Historiis. Hi legant Clementem: qui omnes*
