



EVSEB. CAESARIENSIS.

Eusebius Bishop of *Caesarea Palestina*, formerly called the *Tower of Strato*, for his great friendship towards *Pamphilus*, surnamed also *Pamphilus*, being Scholer to *Dorotheus* the Eunuch, a most learned man, and a most diligent searcher of the Divine Library with *Pamphilus*, was so famous among all the contemporary Bishops of his age for his knowledge in divine and humane Learning; so that his deserts were celebrated with this most noble Eulogie of the Emperour *Constantine*, who would often say, *That it was Eusebius happinesse to bee worthy to be Bishop, not onely of one City, but of the whole World.*
