Efore the passages of this Fathers Life shall be treated of, 'twill not be amisse to discover two things: the first the time in which this St. *Cyrill* lived; for *Bellarmino* placeth him in the yeare 365: his words are, *Sanctus Cyrillus Hierosolymæ Episcopus, &c.* St. *Cyrill* Bishop of *Jerusalem* under *Constantius*, often cast out of his place, by the fury of the *Arrian* faction, but restored, and at last dyed under *Theodosius*. But *Surius* puts him in the yeare of our Lord 340. Now the difference is not to be accounted so great, the one accounting from his birth till hee began to be esteemed of in the Church,
