**H**ere were many of this Name, and therefore it will be convenient and profitable to the Reader to know them, that thereby this famous Father may be distinguished from the rest, and nothing attributed to him, but what doth truly belong to him. There was one that was called *Epiphanius Scholasticus*, because he translated the Tripartite History of the Church out of Greeke into Latin: as *Cassiodorus* testifies, there was a second that was Bishop of *Selybria*, otherwise called *Olybria*, which writ an oration against the burners of *Images*, (as *Possevinus* saith) another was called *Vlpianus* a Sophister,
