Nicephorus the Historian hath taken the greatest paines and travell amongst all others to describe the life of this *Theodoret* at large, and therefore I shall principally follow his steps. This *Theodoret* (saith hee) was born at *Antioch*, a famous place, and an ancient Citie, and renowned for many things; but specially for that, in that the Disciples were first called Christians in this place: as also for the Apostles determining that great question about Circumcision, sent their resolutions to this place, by *Paul* and *Barnabas*, with *Judas* and *Silas*, *The Apostles and the Elders with the Brethren* unto the brethren,
