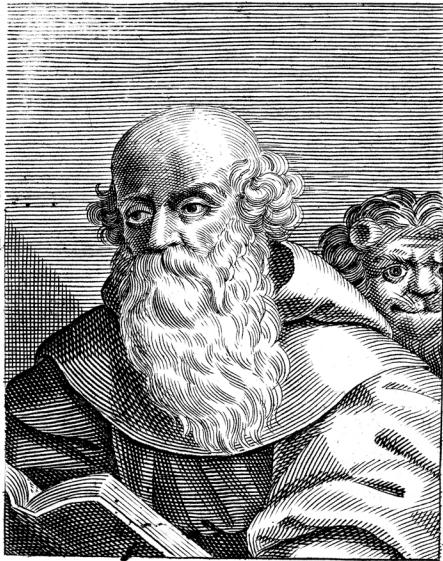

S. HIERONYMVS.

His great and eminent Father of the Church must bee ranked according to his deserts : In writing whose life I follow the directions of *Erasmus of Rotterdam*. To begin therefore ; the time of his Birth was under the Reigne of *Constantine the Great*, in the yeare of Christ 331, in a Towne called *Stridon*, which was ovetrown by the *Gothes*, then waisting and spoyling severall places : Upon the borders of *Dalmatia*, and *Pannonia*, as he himselfe testifies, some, as *Blondus* will have it, to be that which now is called *Sdrigna*, a little Town of *Histria* in *Italie* : some hold, that to this day there is to be seene Saint
