

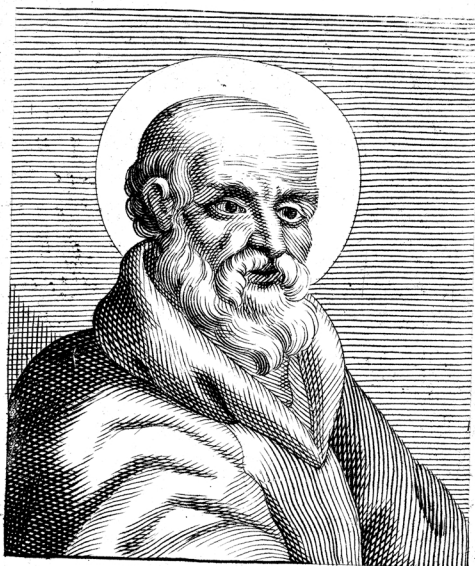

Here is amongst Ecclesiasticall Writers mention made of two of this name, the one was Bishop of *Vtriculanium*, memorable for his holinesse and sincerity of life, and flourished under the reign of *Totila*, King of the *Gothes*, *Justinian* being Emperour, and *Vigilius* Pope. Saint *Gregory* in his third booke of *Dialogues*, in his twelfth Chapter describes him compleatly. This is he, who was one of those two hundred Bishops; which King *Trafamund*, King of the *Vandals*, sent bound into the Island of *Sardinia*, to whom *Symmachus* the Pope sent sufficient daily provision.
