ST. JUDE or JUDAS (not Iscariot.)



St. JUDE was brother to St. James the Lefs, it is not known when or by what means he became a disciple of Christ, nothing being faid of him till we find him mentioned in the catalogue of the twelve apostles, nor asterwards till Christ's last supper. It is thought he preached in Lybia.

The Armenians fay, that St. Jude was the first that

planted christianity among them.

He at last suffered marryrdom in the city of Byretus. St. Jude is sometimes distinguished by Lebbeus, and

or. Jude is formermies outinguined by Leapens, and formermes Thaddeus; the former fignifying a man of wifdom, the latter divine fervor.
