## ST. PHILIP



WAS a native of Bethfaida; it is supposed that he preached the gospel in Upper Asia, and planted christi-

anity in Scythia.

Having for many years preached, haptized and fettled christian churches, healing diseases, and casting out devils with great success. The latter part of his life he spent in Hieropolis, where he gained many to the christian faith, for which he was seized and imprifoned, and afterwards scourged and led to execution, being bound and hanged up against a pillar till he died.

It is faid his body was taken down by St Ba: tholomew, and Philip's own fifter, Marianne, and decently buried; after which, having confirmed the people in

the faith of Christ, they departed.
